Reading	Spelling	Maths skills
• 5 times per week • Plus as many bedtime stories as possible • Lexia also supports (let us know if you have lost your login)	• 3 times per week • Plus look out for spelling words when reading • Lexia also supports	• 2 times per week • Counting forwards and backwards (by the end of Year 1 the children are expected to be able to count forwards and backwards to 100) • Plus bring in the language of maths as often as possible (such as: more/less, as many as, equal) e.g. when shopping or cooking
