



Our enquiry question this term is:
How Diverse Is The Animal Kingdom?



In **Maths** this term we will following up our fractions work with decimals. We then move on to time, money and shape.

Year 4 will be sitting formal timetables tests **early in June**.

In **English** we will be looking at the features of a newspaper report in order to report on some strange sightings of monstrous creatures in the Ledbury area. We will be writing a story based on a folk tale and instructions about training monsters. We will continue to work on improving our grammar such as using brackets to add information and use of punctuation when writing instructions. our reading focus will be on inference.



We will be covering a lot of **Science** this term. We start off looking at living things and their habitats and then move on to looking at animals, including humans. We will look at the structure of teeth and what they are used for, as well as how to look after them. We also study the digestive system – what organs are involved and how long does it take?



In **Computing** this term, we will continue to talk about e-safety but will also be working on a video project for our digital design topic.

In **Music**, we will studying a unit based around The Beatles, equality and human rights. We will also study the history of music and listen to classical pieces.



In **Religion and World Views** this term, we will be talking how and why people mark significant events in life looking at Christianity, Judaism and Hinduism. What are the similarities and differences?

Our **PE** this term is based on target games with a focus on archery. We will work on technique specifically how to use our bodies to improve our aim.



In **French**, we are going to be learning to name and describe animals and talk about where they live.

This term in **Art** we look at the work of Seurat and the Pointillism movement before trying to produce our own work in a similar style.



Our **DT** project this term is all about movement. Can we use air to make our monster move?
