



Read Write Inc.

At Ledbury Primary School, we teach phonics in Nursery, Reception and years 1, 2 and 3 through the Read Write Inc. programme.

This programme is for primary school children learning to read.

It enables **every child** to become a confident and fluent reader at **the first attempt**.

Why does it work?

- The systematic and lively programme is organised by an in-school manager
- All staff (teachers and assistants) are trained together
- The children read and write each day, grouped according to their reading level.

How and what do the children learn?

READING

The children:

- learn 44 sounds and the corresponding letters/letter groups using simple picture prompts
- learn to read words using sound blending (Fred Talk)
- read lively stories featuring words they have learned to sound out
- after meaningful discussion led by an adult children show that they comprehend the stories by answering questions

WRITING

The children:

- learn to write the letters/letter groups which represent the 44 sounds
- learn to write words by saying the sounds and graphemes

TALKING

Children are assessed so they work with children at the same level. This allows them to take a full part in all lessons.

They work in pairs so that they:

- answer every question
- practise every activity with their partner
- take turns in talking to each other
