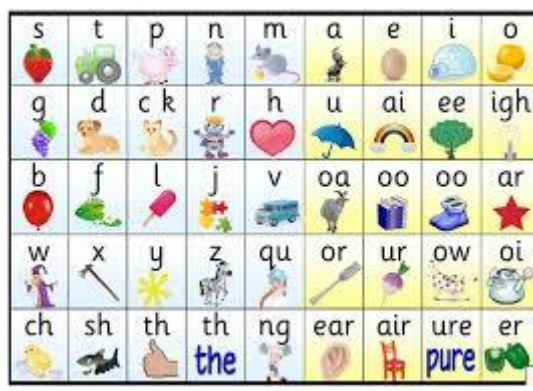


Computer and iPad Phonics Links/Games for Parents

Initial Letter Sounds and CVC words



Phonics Play www.phonicsplay.co.uk	Only some games are free before you have to subscribe. You should select Phase 2 and select the sound that your child needs to focus on. The main games are: • Buried Treasure (CVC words) • Dragon's Den (CVC words) • Obb and Bob (CVC words) • Pick a Picture (sound out the CVC word or recognise the initial letter sound and select the correct picture to match).

All of these games are free on this website and are fun and interactive phonics games which can support phoneme recognition, segmenting and blending in a fun way. • Phoneme Pop (initial letter sounds) • Letter Lifter –hear, select and type initial letter sound. • Phonics Fighter – select the picture that has the letter displayed as the initial sound in the word. • 3 Letter House – blending and segmenting CVC – parent/carer can select the middle and final sounds – link to focus sounds given. • CVC Pop – you can select the middle vowel sound for the CVC words. • Tell A T-Rex – Reading questions built with mostly CVC words.
