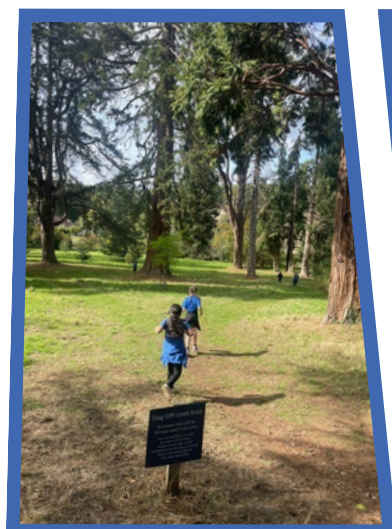
Children's assemblies
