Our annual visit to the Deer Park care home to decorate their Christmas trees was this week. The House Captains loved chatting to the residents and made a lovely job of the trees!

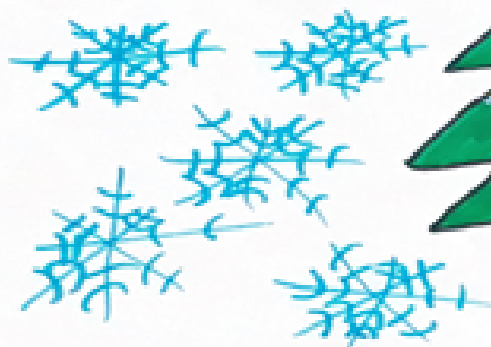


Open the Book Nativity
