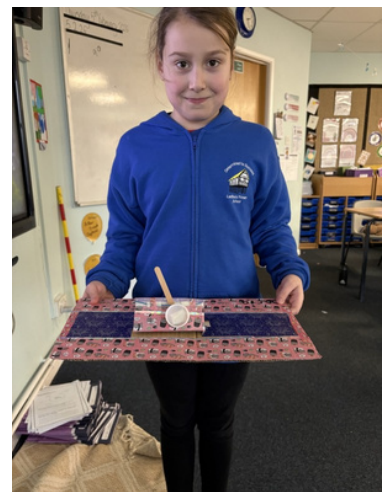
RECEPTION VISIT ST MICHAELS
