



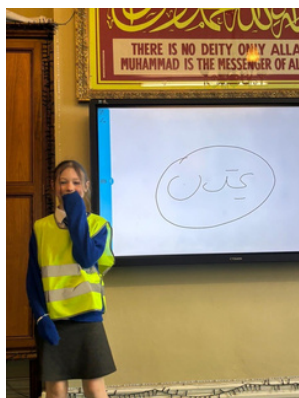

It was wonderful to see our children confidently sharing their own beliefs and using subject-specific vocabulary to explore big questions in a safe, collaborative environment.

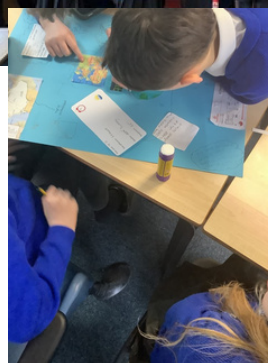
This dedicated week successfully fostered a sense of belonging and helped our children grow as understanding young people within our school community.



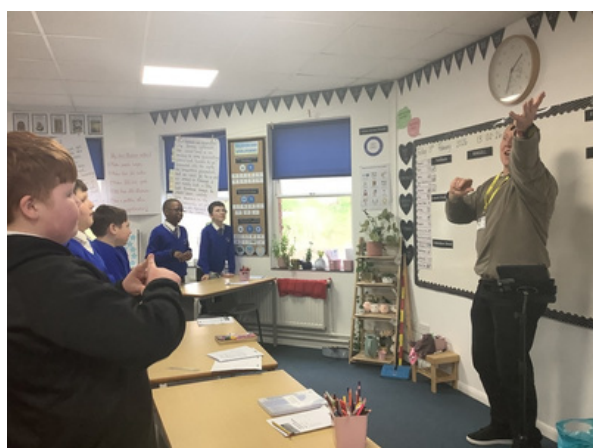
