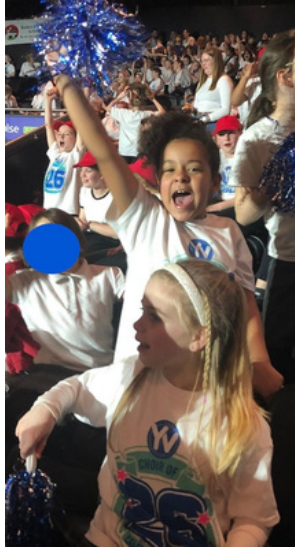
YOUNG VOICES
