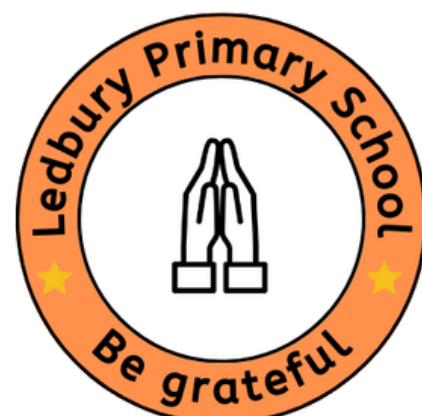

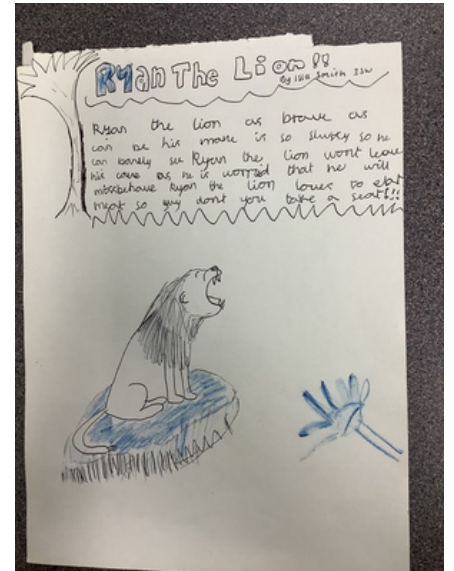
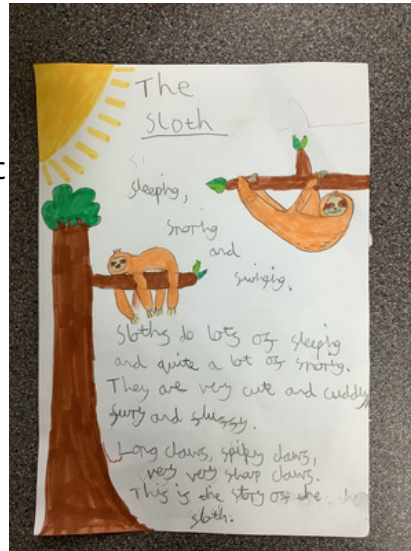
WORLD BOOK DAY
