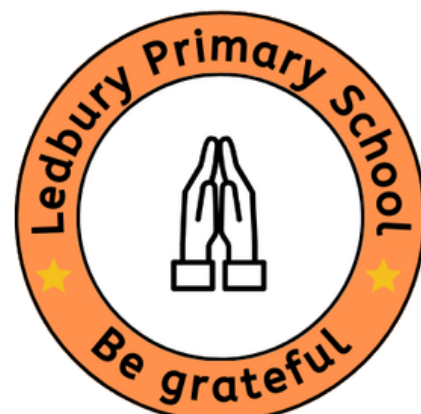

You can present your family history in a creative way. For example, you might write a short story, make a poster, draw a family tree, or include photos and drawings. Your entry must fit an A4 sheet

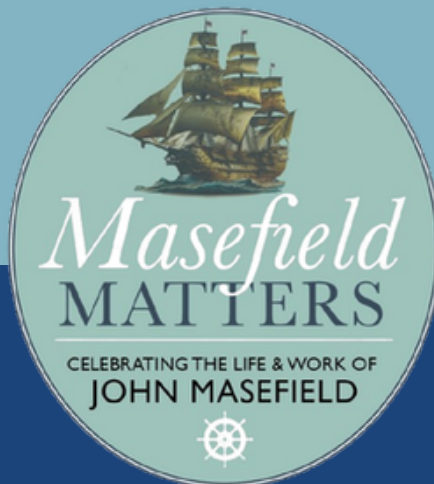
