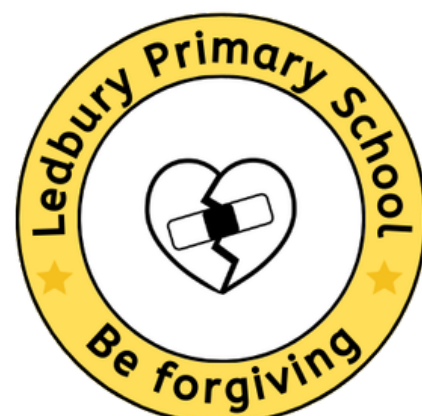
Cricket Day
