- After the verification step, please answer the short questionnaire.

Tickets for the lottery cost just £1 per week. There is a guaranteed cash winner for your school every week and the chance to win the £25,000 jackpot.

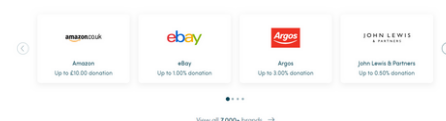

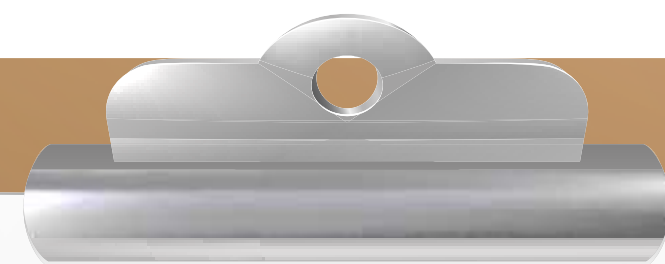

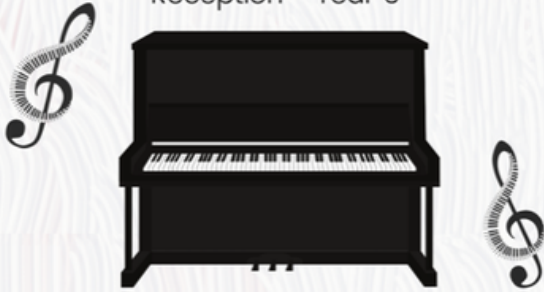
