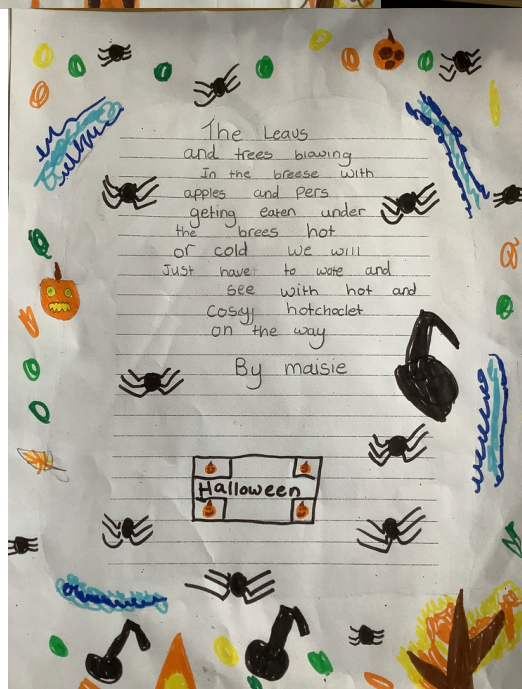
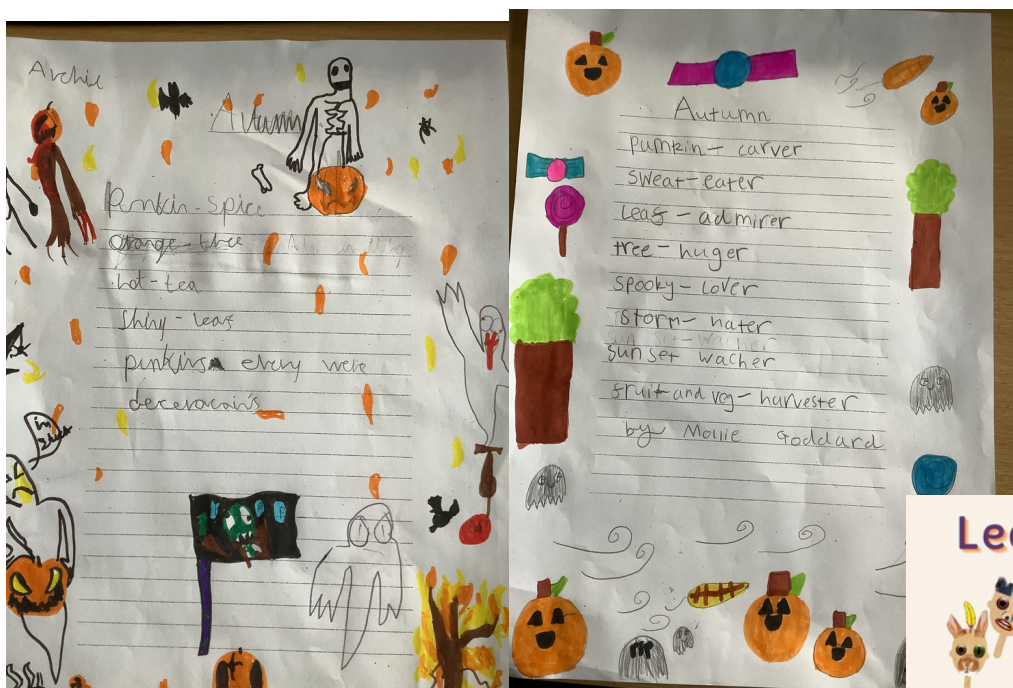
IMPORTANT DATE
