KS2 loved their trip to see Sleeping Beauty at the Courtyard. It was fun watching Mr Banks getting involved too!

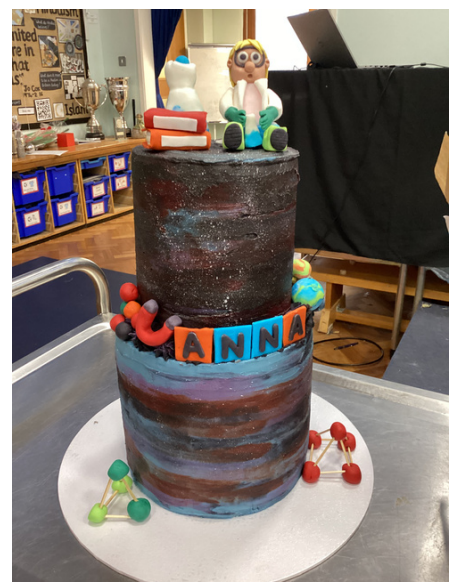
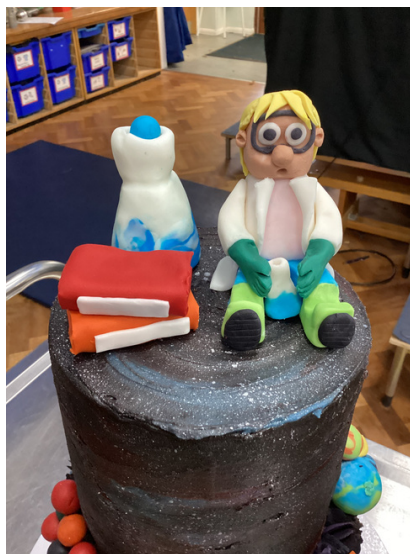


EYFS and KS1 have enjoyed Jack and the Beanstalk in school this week. The children thought it was really funny and they especially loved the cow!
