Volunteering Opportunity

The Friends of Ledbury Children's Centre are looking for volunteers to help with groups on Wednesday and Friday afternoons.

The Children's Centre is for families with babies and children 0-5 years. Different group sessions take place there and also Midwifery, Health Visitor developmental checks, baby weighing, speech and language therapy etc.

The Friends of Ledbury Children's Centre is a small voluntary group running sessions on a Wednesday and Friday afternoon, 1.30 – 3.00 pm, for parents and carers with babies and children 0 to 5 years to attend.

On a Wednesday afternoon there are various play and craft activities, followed by a short interactive story, songs and snack time (healthy snacks) with warm drinks for parents and carers. All of our activities are to encourage children to explore, promote language, social skills and curiosity and of course have fun!

There is a garden outside which the Friends have done a lot of work in and the children are encouraged to go outside to explore, dig, water and plant etc and just enjoy getting messy. Digging up the potatoes they have grown is like looking for buried treasure!. We then try and cook them for snack so they get to eat them too.

The sessions are very much 'free flow' and so the children can wander in and out as they please with adult supervision.

On a Friday the session is slightly less structured, indoor and outdoor play activities using a range of resources, mark making, construction, physical etc. There is a small Sensory Room too;

Our role as volunteers is to provide a warm welcome to families, engage with parents/carers and children, encouraging them to play with whatever resources are out in a safe, friendly environment. The sessions are usually fairly small, around 6 babies and children plus parents.

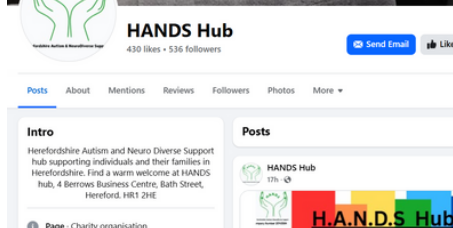
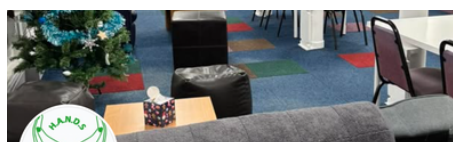
