IF YOU FEEL
YOU ARE BEING BULLIED**



Tell Someone
If you are being bullied it's really important that you speak to someone about it. Keeping things bottled up isn't a good idea. People won't be able to help you if they don't know what is going on. Tell someone that you trust. It's good to talk.

Don't Retaliate
Hope was really brave and stood up for herself. She told Amy she wasn't going to let her bully her anymore. However, she wasn't mean and she didn't attempt to 'bully back'. If someone is treating you badly, avoid the temptation to treat them badly too.

Remember It's Not Your Fault
Sometimes people have things going on in their lives that affect the way they treat people. This might have absolutely nothing to do with you. It's important to remember that you can't always control the way other people behave. Being bullied is NOT your fault.

Be Proud of Who You Are
We are all individual and unique. It's important to celebrate the things that make us different. Joe loved dancing and drama but tried to keep it quiet because he was scared of what Amy would think. Hope had a great singing voice but was afraid to enter the competition as it would draw attention to her. This is your life so make sure it's the best life possible - don't let anyone bring you down.
