HISTORY

History at LPS

At Ledbury Primary School, History is taught in reverse chronological order to support the children's understanding of chronology. (see our topics below)

The whole school teaches history in the autumn term, and it includes time dedicated to the study of World War Two and its impact on British and World history.

By the time the children leave Year 6, they will have studied a broad range of topics covering important events and periods in Britain's history and that of the wider world.

Links with other areas of the curriculum are embraced to provide a more meaningful learning experience.



Year 1	Why did man want to fly and has it been a good thing? Curriculum links: - events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally - the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements
Year 2	What rights did children have in Victorian Britain? Curriculum links: - events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally - the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements
Year 3	How did the reign of Henry VIII affect Britain and Ledbury? Curriculum links: - a study of an aspect or theme in British history that extends pupils' chronological knowledge beyond 1066 - a local study - a non-European society that provides contrast with British history - Mayan civilization c. AD 900 (spring term)
Year 4	Were the English ever English? Curriculum links: - Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and Scots - the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor
Year 5	How did the ancients control water and how did water control them? Curriculum links: - the achievements of the earliest civilizations – an overview of where and when the first civilizations appeared and a depth study of Ancient Egypt - Ancient Greece – a study of Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world - the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain
Year 6	How has humankind impacted on their world? Curriculum links: - changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age - a study of an aspect or theme in British history that extends pupils' chronological knowledge beyond 1066
