Many thanks for the kind donations of cakes and to all who came to support this event. We raised a fantastic £870.52.



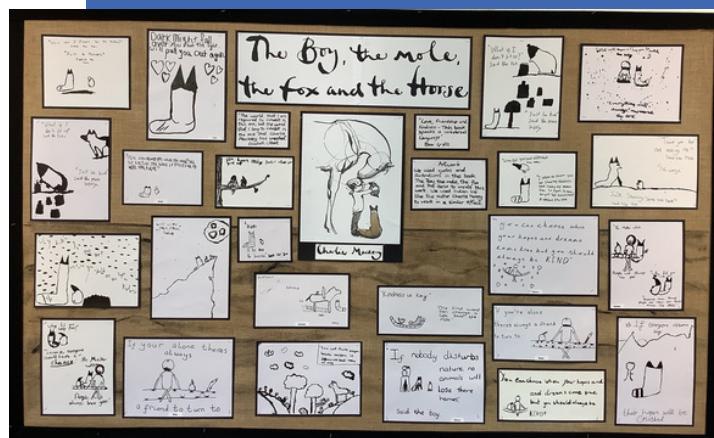
Staffing news

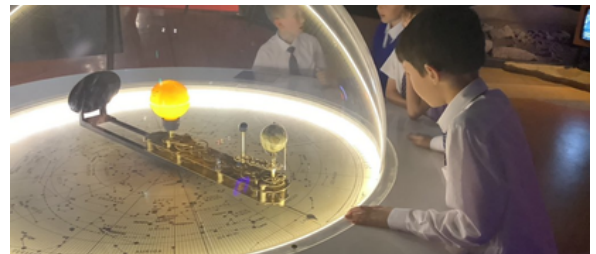
Davant have generously pledged £783 to cover the cost of the Alice in Wonderland production.
