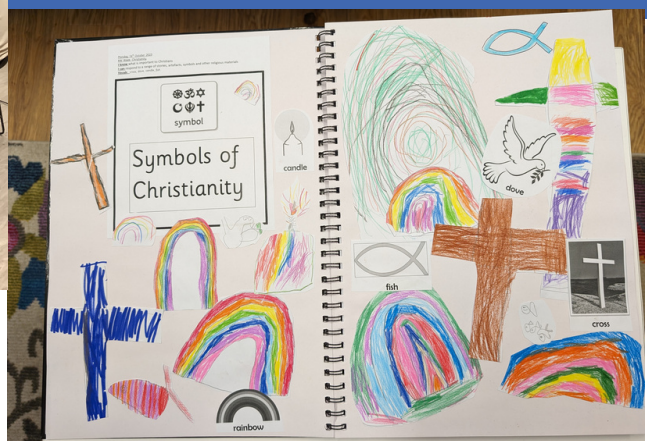

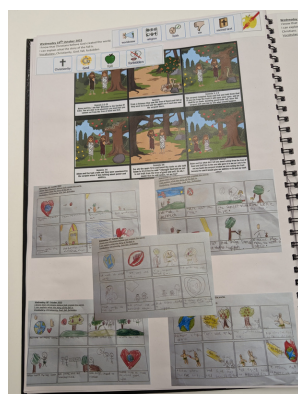
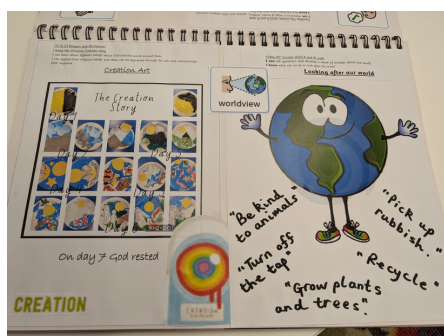
Religion & Worldviews week

Religion and Worldviews Week at LPS is always a favourite with pupils and staff. We love the opportunity to take a break from some of our usual subjects and focus in on this important topic.

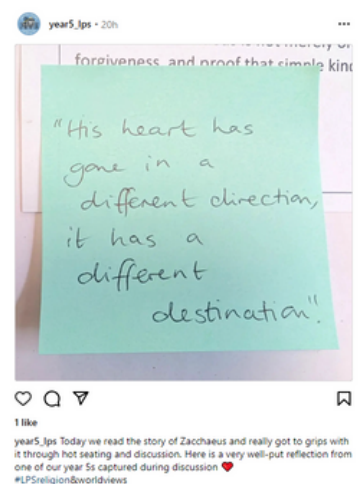
We know that everyone has a world-view (religious or non-religious) and a recent name change has helped us appreciate that this subject really is for everyone! Children relish the chance to express their ideas and views and to discuss important topics such as belief and faith, right and wrong, special times, places and stories, important life milestones and core values. At the same time children are learning how to value everyone's points of view by listening better and appreciating one another's differences. We know how important this is as we prepare our young people to be respectful and understanding adults.

This term, each class has focused on a Christianity unit before we move on in Spring and Summer to World Religions. The school has been a hive of activity this week with outdoor sessions, philosophy, drama, collaboration and art playing a central role in our learning. A big change this year is a move away from individual books and folders to whole-class floorbooks. Our children have embraced this new approach and have enjoyed contributing to them.
