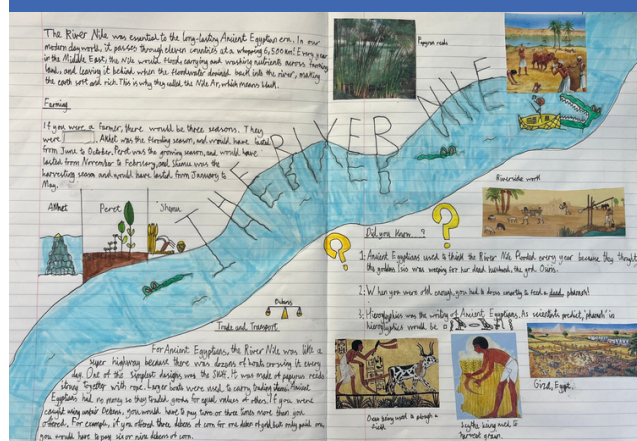

HISTORY



WWII week

In addition to our diverse History topics, each year the whole school has a focus on learning about World War 2.

Nursery have been thinking about Remembrance Day and why the symbol of the poppy is so important for many people in our community and beyond. They watched this CBeebies short film about the hare and the origin of the poppy symbol and went on a poppy hunt around school.



Reception have learnt about Stubby, the stray dog who helped American soldiers in World War 1. He went to war in France, was injured and returned a hero. The children have been drawing and making purple and red poppies, helping us to remember the soldiers and animals that help to keep us safe.

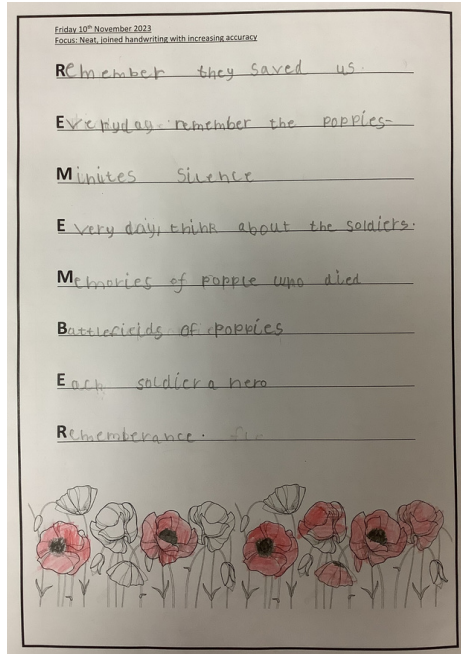


Year 1 learnt about the Spitfire aeroplane which is linked to their topic of flight. They also looked at the spitfire in science and talked about the materials used to build it and why they were chosen.

Year 2 have focused on evacuees during WW2. They asked the question, 'Was it right for children to be evacuated?' Y2 agreed it was the right decision to keep the children safe but felt the children must have felt very scared leaving their families. They then thought about what an evacuee would have packed in their case in 1939 and compared this to a case packed today in 2023.



WWII week continued...



Year 3 have been learning about the reasons why WWII started, the countries and key figures involved. They then looked at evacuees and how children would have felt during this time. Y3 finished their week writing an acrostic poem!

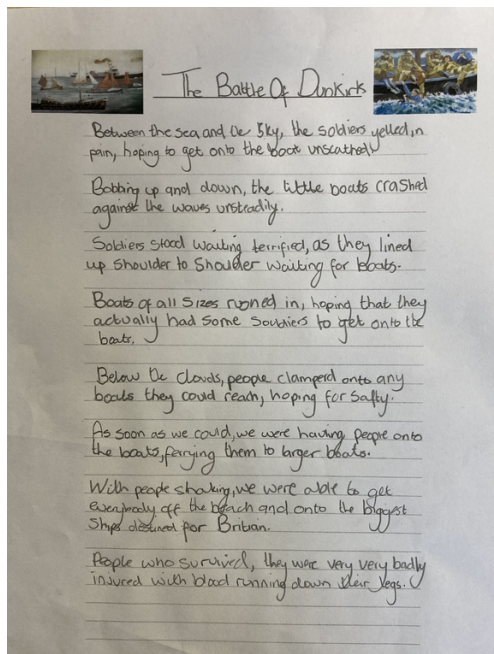
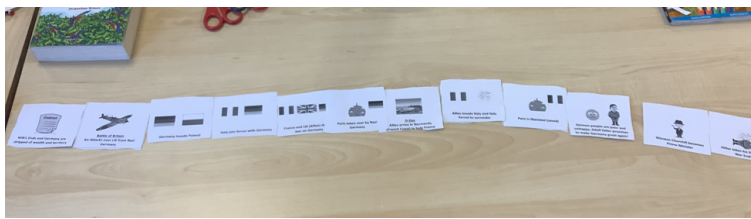
Year 4 focused on the timeline of WW2 and how the main events sequenced throughout. They also revised the invasion of Jersey and discussed whether they would have evacuated their home towns if they learnt of an attack, or stayed and learnt to live by the ways of another country.

Year 5's focus was the Navy. They looked into the history of events that took place on the beaches of Dunkirk in 1945 and the armada of ships that came from Britain, in all shapes and sizes, to play their part in 'Operation Dynamo'.

They read the story 'Little Ships' By Louise Borden. Using literacy devices they created their own poems, describing the scenes at Dunkirk.

They also took a closer look at the ships used in the rescue and sketched their own boats from close observation of line and shape. Y5 then used watercolours to add depth and drama to their pictures.

Year 6 have enjoyed making books to put all their WWII work in this term. The first page is all about Morse Code and they will continue to explore this topic for the rest of the term.
