Every Day Counts....

Attendance at LPS

Attendance is a high priority at Ladbury Primary School. Evidence shows that children who have excellent attendance do well both academically and socially. Our aim is to work with families to support and improve attendance.

We need your support by ensuring

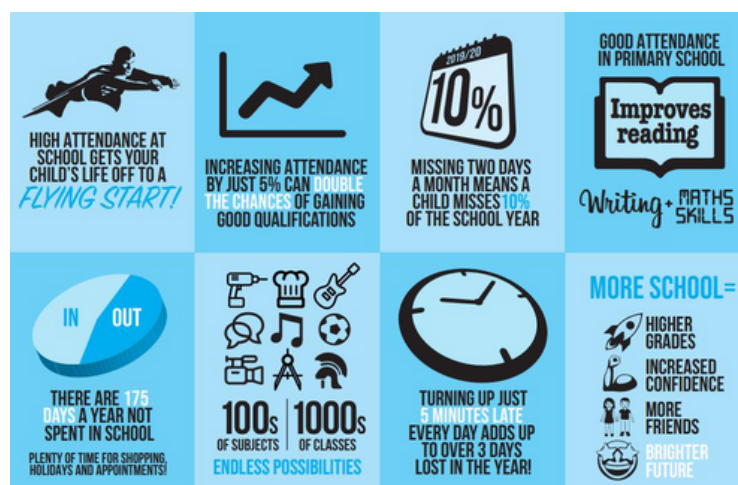
- ❖ your child attends every day on time
- ❖ you call the school / use the app to report absence before 9am on the day of the absence (and each subsequent day of absence), and advise when they are expected to return
- ❖ you provide the school with more than one emergency contact number for your child
- ❖ where possible, appointments for your child are made outside of the school day

Reporting about absence

If school has concerns about your child's attendance we may call or arrange a meeting to discuss this further. You may also receive a text message or email with more information highlighting concerns. Every term we will indicate on reports if your child's attendance is

- excellent (above 97%)
- expected (95-97%)
- cause for concern (less than 95%)

We have 190 school days every year. If your child has 19 or more days off, for any reason, then they are classed as being 'persistently absent' which is a concern.

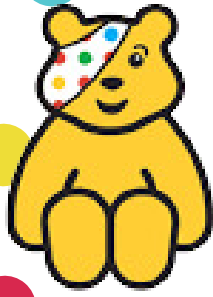

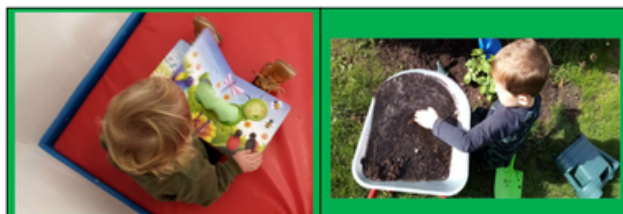
