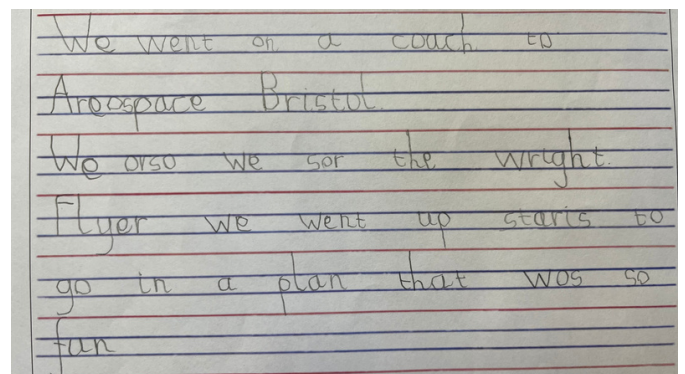

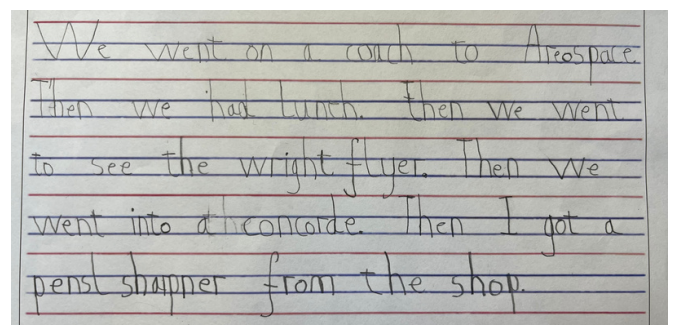

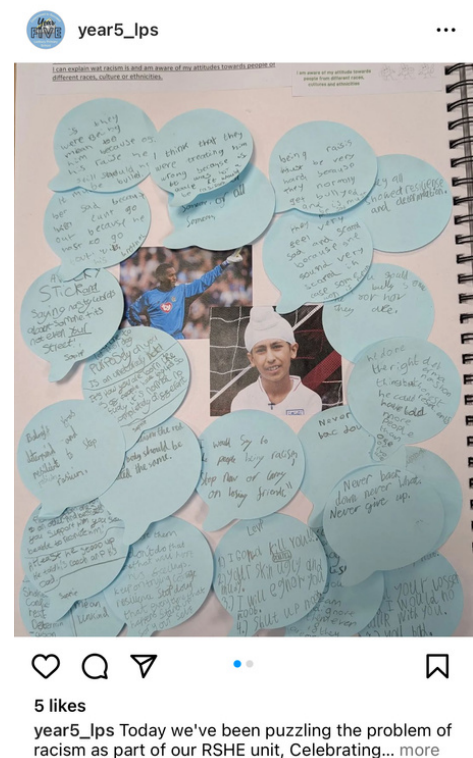


Our new social media accounts

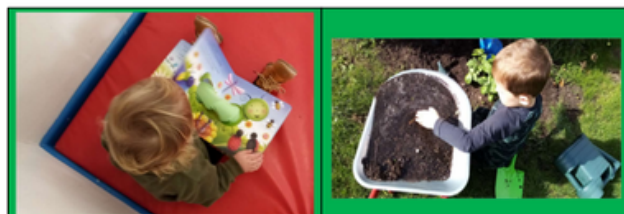
