Modern Foreign Languages

At Ledbury Primary, hearing confident young people chanting, singing, having conversations and lots of laughter in another language is a joy. We recently introduced a new scheme of work called Primary Languages Network, which allows all pupils in KS2 to be taught by a native French speaker facilitated by their class teacher. The curiosity and confidence our pupils demonstrate are just two key reasons why we believe that all pupils should experience specialist modern language learning from an early age.

Each lesson is designed to develop each pupils understanding of new vocabulary, the pronunciation and grammar used to say, read and eventually write in French. This is done through verbal repetition, singing songs and lots of fun games!

Should I keep my child off school?

Yes

	Until...
Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

Head lice	Tonsillitis
Threadworms	Slapped cheek

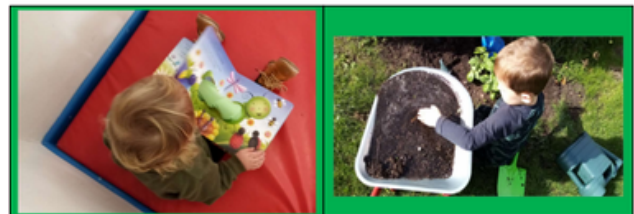

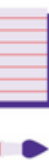
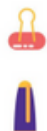
