Here are some of the events planned so far for the rest of the year:

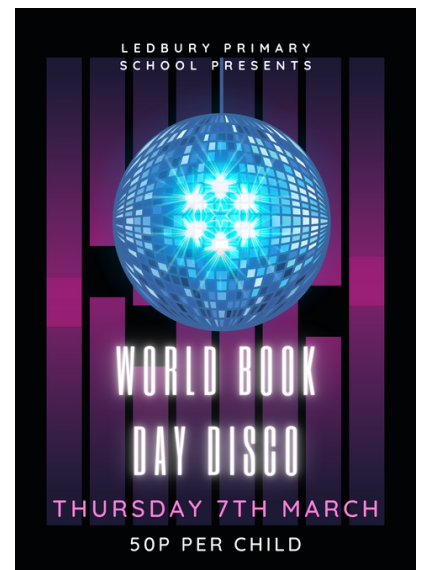
Family Film Night- Monday 29th January

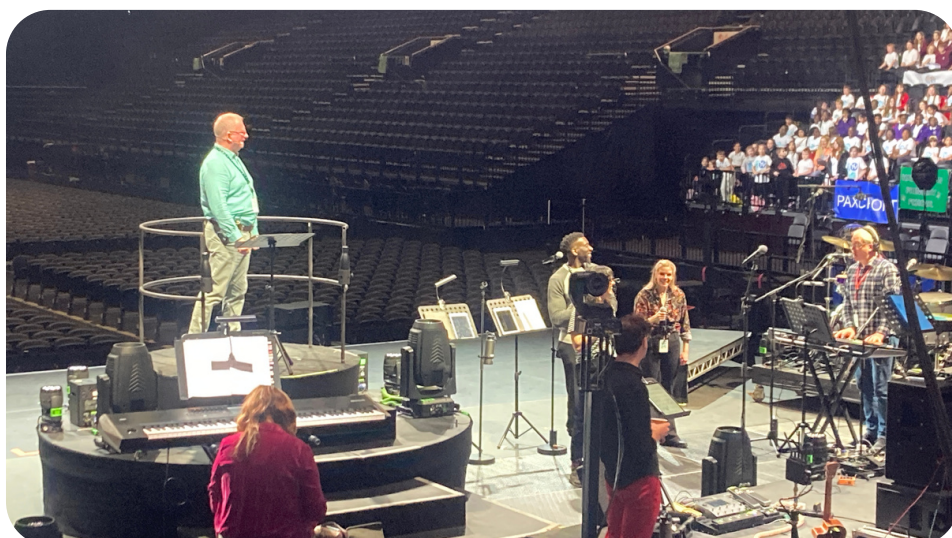
