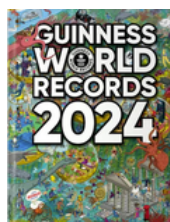
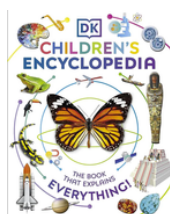

We celebrate successes with our KS2 leaderboard and our new Y2 display.

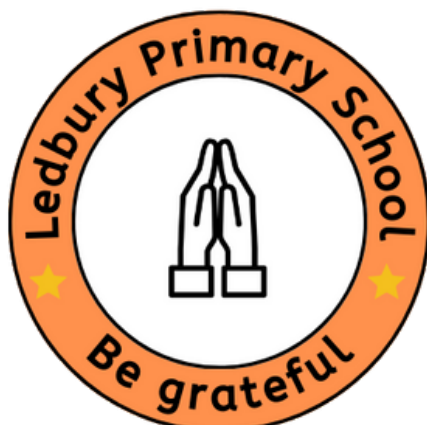


SPOTLIGHT ON...

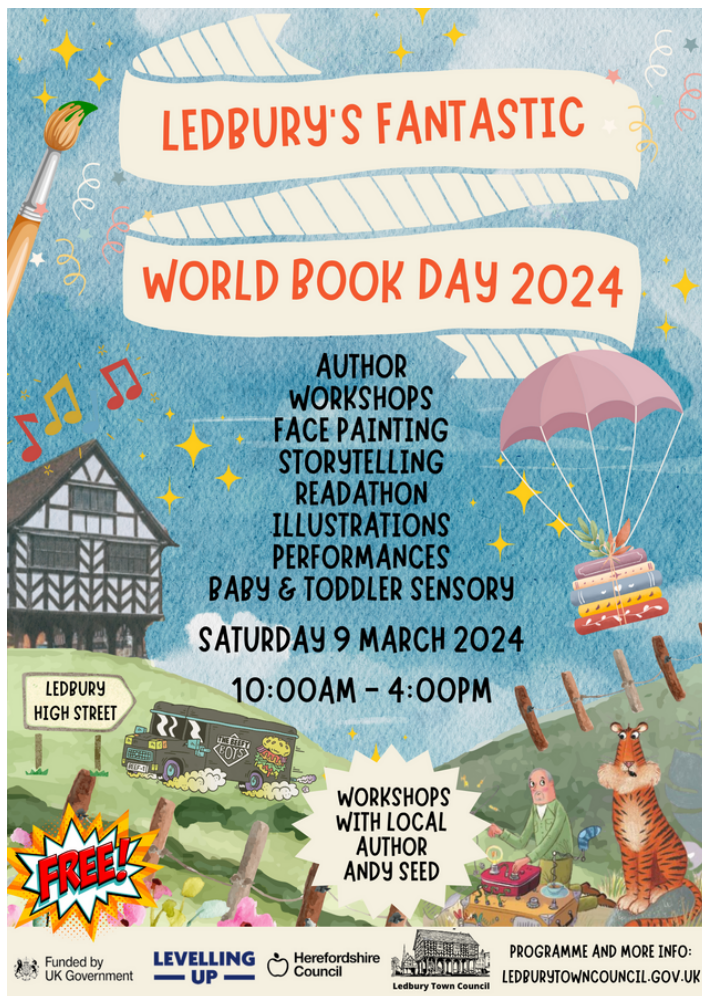
