Y5 VISIT TO THE MOSQUE

As part of our Religion and Worldviews week Y5 visited a Mosque.

When we arrived we had to take off our shoes to keep the Mosque clean. Next we went upstairs to wear some Muslim clothes. After that we went to the washroom to perform Wudu. We had to wash our body in order- hands, face, heads, arms, legs then feet. Finally the man took us back into the main prayer room again and answered some questions.

Then we went to the next floor and tried on clothes. We also tried on caps but the girls wore a Hijab. After that we went to the washroom to perform Wudu and they wash before the pray to make sure they are clean.

Their god is called Allah and his prophet was called Muhamed. We also saw a Mihrab and it was so cool. A Qubva was amazing and inside it was very well decorated with lots of gold. Their flag is a crescent and a star and it's all green. They also have something called a Minaret which is designed so the call of the prayer is heard from the top of the Mosque so they know when it is time to pray.

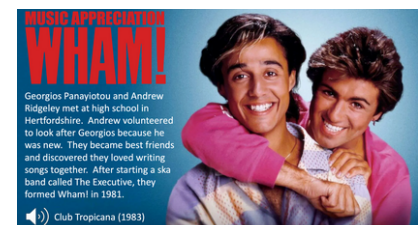
MUSIC CELEBRATION
