Here's what some of our pupils thought:

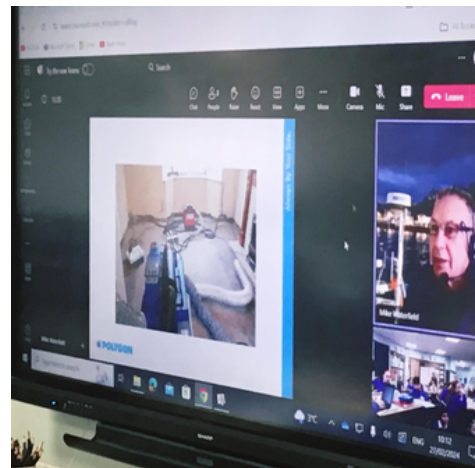
Bobby - It was very interesting to learn about the floods and how it affected people.

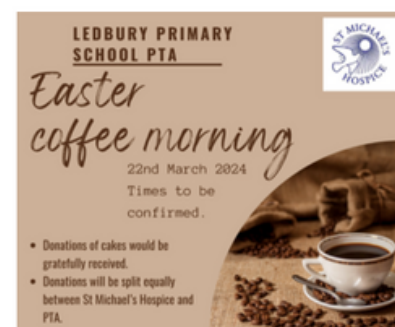

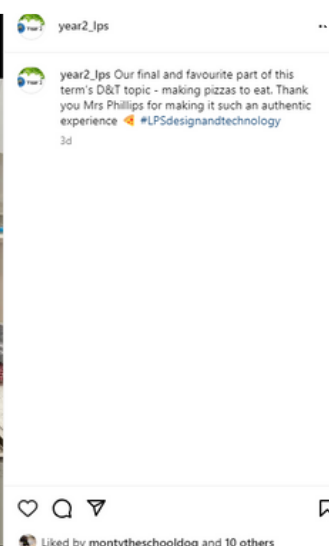
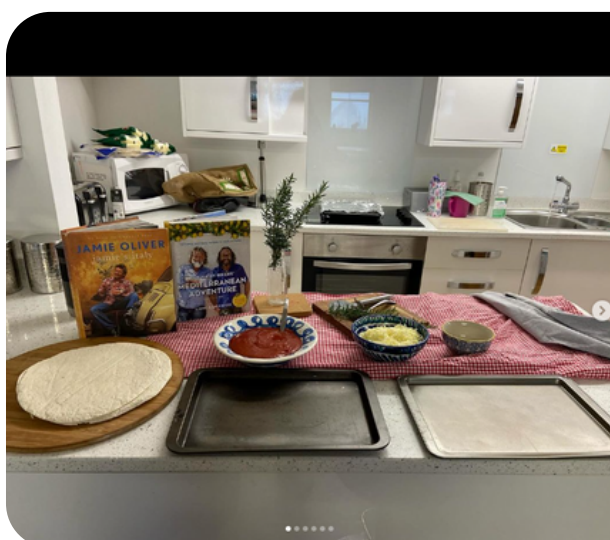
