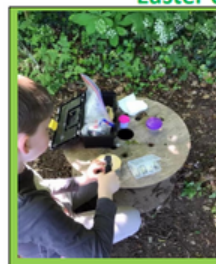
Fun in the Forest

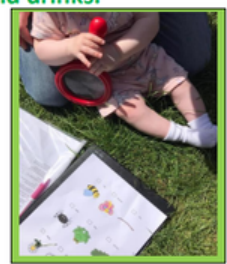
Enjoy an afternoon of Springtime family fun.
