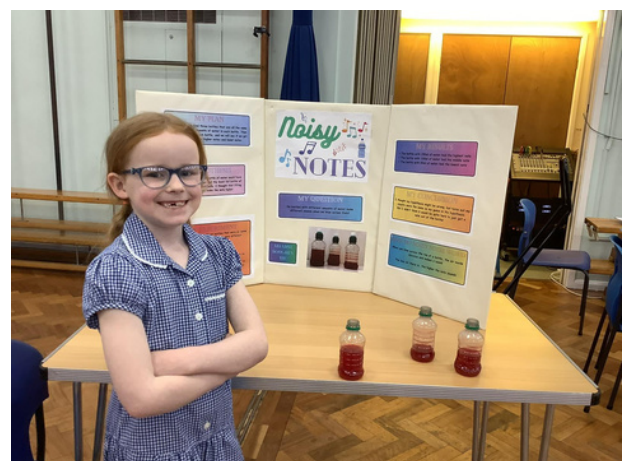
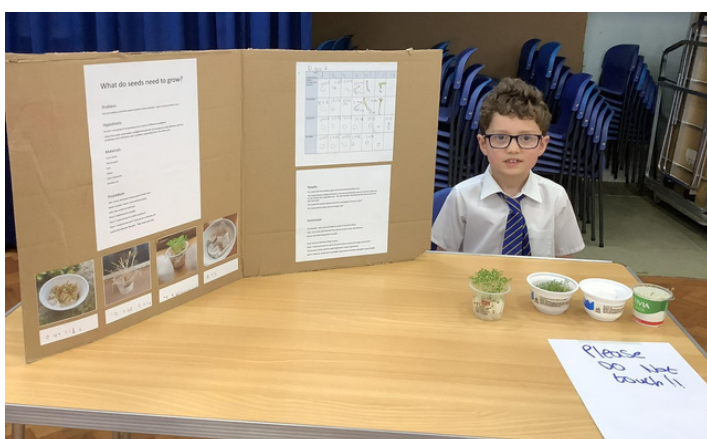
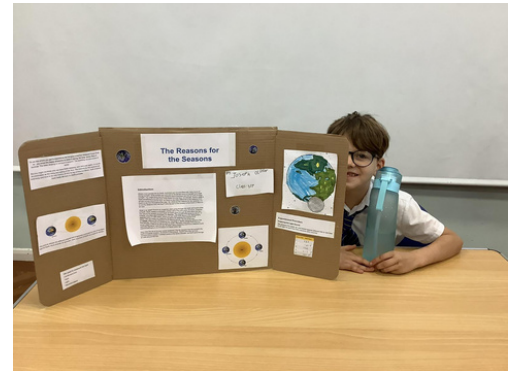
Science Fair

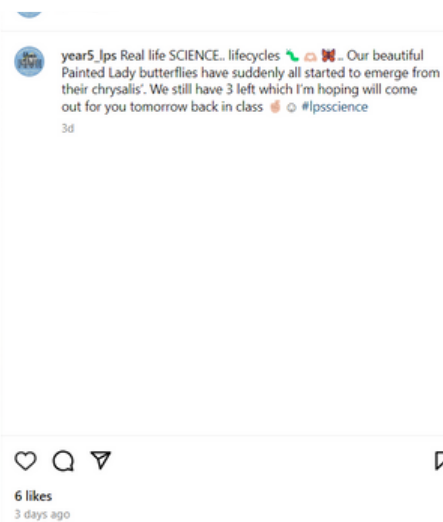
