Working with colour

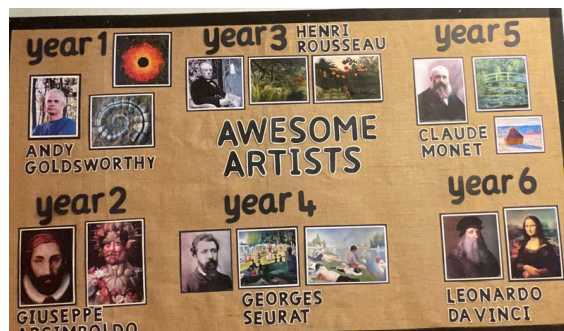
Sculpture
