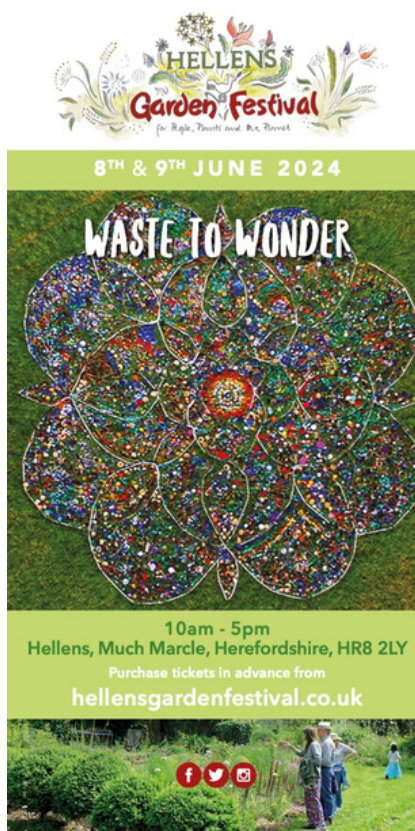

CAMP ACTIVITIES

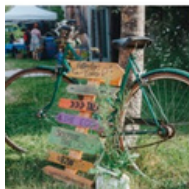
We aim to provide your child with a fun and exciting variety of sports and other activities (cooking, arts crafts and design, playground games, and more whilst on camp with us.
