Y5 TRIP TO THE NATIONAL SPACE CENTRE

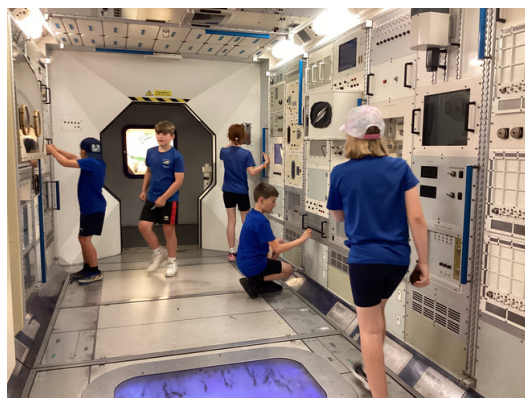

There was a model of the International Space Station which they called "Columbus".
