SKATEBOARDING WORKSHOP

In preparation for our Olympic themed carnival week, children have been participating in a skateboarding workshops. It was amazing to see their skills develop!

Skateboarding will be one of five new sports at the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games and will consist of two disciplines for both men and women: street and park.

The street events will take place on a straight street-like course and each athlete will take it in turns to show off their variety of tricks across the various rails, walls, ramps and stairs dotted across the course. Park events will feature in a hollowed-out course with the added attraction of further tricks performed mid-air drawing the crowds.
